For what purpose and on what legal basis is the data processed?	<p>A1 Group informs the capital market (primarily institutional investors and analysts) at least on a quarterly basis about the results of the past quarter and current developments and provides an outlook for the further course of business. One communication channel is the presentation by the Management Board, moderated by Investor Relations. The event is to be recorded for the purpose of subsequently making the audio track available on the A1 Group website for investors, analysts and other interested parties in terms of good investor relations.</p> <p>The digital communication channel is Microsoft Teams ("MS Teams").</p> <p>The legal basis for the data processing is legitimate interest (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f of the General Data Protection Regulation, "GDPR").</p>
What personal data is processed?	<p>On the occasion of a call, the following personal data of the participants will be processed: First and last name, e-mail address, photo (optional), telephone number (if dialled in via telephone).</p> <p>Meeting metadata: Date, time, meeting ID, topic, description (optional), participant IP addresses, device/hardware information.</p> <p>Text, audio and video data: You have the option to use the chat function in an online meeting. To this extent, the text entries you make are processed in order to display them in the call and, if necessary, to log them. In order to enable the display of video and the playback of audio, the data from the microphone of your terminal device and from any video camera of the terminal device are processed accordingly during the call. You can switch off or mute the camera or microphone yourself at any time via the MS Teams applications.</p> <p>In addition, video, audio and presentation recordings as well as the text file of the online meeting chat are processed on the occasion of the recording.</p>
Where does the personal data originate from?	The personal data is provided to us by you, the data subject.



Will the data be transferred to a third country or an international organisation?	MS Teams is a service provided by the provider Microsoft Ireland Operations Limited ("Microsoft") with headquarters in the USA. A (partial) processing of personal data in a third country, i.e. a country outside of the European Union ("EU") or the contracting states to the Agreement on the European Economic Area ("EEA") can therefore not be excluded. We have concluded an data processing agreement with Microsoft including the EU standard contractual clauses, whereby Microsoft is obliged to comply with data protection and information security in accordance with the requirements applicable in the EU.
How long is my personal data processed?	The video and audio recording will be converted into an audio-only track in a timely manner after the respective call. Thereafter, the original video and audio recording and other data will be deleted immediately. The audio-only data will be deleted after 10 years at the latest.
What rights do I have when my personal data is processed?	<p>Right of access: You can request confirmation as to whether and to what extent Telekom Austria AG processes your data. In order to protect the data, it may be necessary for us to carry out an identity check.</p> <p>Right to rectification: If A1 Group processes personal data of yours that is incomplete or incorrect, you may request that it will be corrected or completed at any time.</p> <p>Right to erasure: You may request the erasure of personal data if A1 Group processes it unlawfully or if the processing disproportionately interferes with legitimate interests of protection. However, there may be reasons that prevent immediate deletion, e.g. in the case of legally regulated retention obligations.</p> <p>Right to restriction of processing: You may request the restriction of the processing of your data if</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• you dispute the accuracy of the data for a period of time that allows us to verify the accuracy of the data.• the processing of the data is unlawful, but you object to erasure and request restriction of data use instead,• A1 Group no longer needs the data for the intended purpose, but you still need this data to assert or defend legal claims, or• you have objected to the processing of the data. <p>Right to data portability: You may request that A1 Group provides the data provided in a structured, common and machine-readable format, provided that</p>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• this data is processed on the basis of a given and revocable consent or for the performance of a contract, and• this processing is carried out by automated means. <p>Right to object: If A1 Group processes your data for the performance of tasks in the public interest, for the exercise of official authority or if the processing is based on the need to protect its legitimate interest, you may object to this data processing if there is an overriding interest in protecting the data.</p>
Where can I turn to?	If you are of the opinion that we are violating Austrian or European data protection law in the processing of your data, we request that you contact us in order to clarify any issues. Of course, you also have the right to complain to the Austrian data protection authority (www.dsb.gv.at), as well as to a supervisory authority within the EU.
Are automated decision-making processes used?	A1 Group does not use automated decision-making for the above-mentioned processing purposes that has legal effect or similarly significantly affects you.
